Space is plentiful in the rooms and suites, as is sunshine, a welcome departure from the cruise-ship theme, and one side of the hotel has a front-row view of the Thames.

#### DAY 1 | April 28

Individual arrivals at the Sea Containers hotel. Accommodations include daily English breakfast. Tonight, we'll gather for a fantastic Welcome Dinner.

#### **DAY 2 | April 29**

We'll meet in Studio 4 each morning for our discussion series. This morning, Michael Billington of *The Guardian* will give an overview of the plays we'll be seeing. An optional show will be offered this afternoon. You'll also have time to eat dinner at a nearby restaurant before we see our first performance.

#### **DAY 3 | April 30**

Morning discussion, moderated by Vincent M. Lancisi, with, perhaps, the playwright whose show we saw last night. We'll offer an optional dinner before seeing our second performance, perhaps a compelling drama at the National Theatre.

## **DAY 4 | May 1**

We'll have a guest speaker in the morning, perhaps an accomplished U.K. director. In the afternoon, we'll take a private tour of a leading exhibit. This evening, we may head to the Royal Court or Almeida.

#### **DAY 5 | May 2**

Vincent M. Lancisi leads a discussion with a leading London Artistic Director or actor. Your afternoon is free. In the evening, perhaps we'll venture to the Hampstead Theatre. But first, join us as we say "farewell" to each other at one of the finest restaurants in the city.
